- U18 division minimum rank green belt for Tori and orange for Uke.
- U16 division, minimum rank orange belt for Tori and yellow Uke.

NOTES: *The age division will be determined by both partners.*

A maximum of two (2) different katas per age division as Tori and/or Uke.

A competitor may only participate once in the same Kata either as Tori or Uke in each age division.

TOURNAMENT:	<p>Saturday Morning: (warm up at 7:00)</p> <p>Competition starts at 8:00 sharp.</p> <p>Note: the order of kata will be announced at 7:00 AM.</p>
RULES AND REGULATIONS:	<p>The tournament will follow Judo Canada and the 2025 IJF rules and regulations in judging this tournament.</p> <p>Judo Canada judogis rules must be followed.</p> <p>Female participants must wear a white t-Shirt with short sleeves and a round collar (no v-necks) under their judogi. The shirt must be long enough to tuck into the judogi pants.</p> <p>The judogi must be white. No judogi of any other colour will be accepted.</p> <p>No musical katas are accepted.</p> <p>There are no gender divisions in the tournament. All female, all male and mixed teams are accepted.</p>
SURFACES:	<p>There are two (2) surfaces of competition of eight (8) meters by eight (8) meters with a four (4) meter safety between them.</p> <p>A white strip of tape, 50 cm long, will be fixed at six (6) meters at the center of the competition area to indicate the starting positions for Tori and Uke. There will also be a tape indicating the center of the competition area.</p>
INJURIES:	<p>If Tori and Uke are not able to continue for reasons of an injury, sickness, or an accident during the execution of the kata, the pair will be eliminated from the tournament.</p> <p>In case of Minor injury like bloody wound, broken nail or a problem with contact lenses, according to the decision of the judges, the Kata execution will be stopped, and the athlete will be assisted by a Sport Therapist out of the competition area. The competition will continue, and the pair will repeat entirely the Kata soon after the last called pair.</p> <p>In case a new Minor injury happens to the same athlete during the second execution of Kata, the pair will be considered out of competition.</p> <p>In the case that a Minor injury happens after a forgotten technique or a major mistake, the pair will be considered out of competition.</p>
